whereas Adam Shapley of Anne Arundel County in our said Province
of Maryland hath drawn unto him five hundred Acres of Land with more and
promised by assignment from Richard Board of the said County part of a
warrant for those Richard Acres granted the said Board that twenty
seventh day of February one thousand six hundred Eighty six as appears
upon Record and upon such conditions and terms as are expressed in the
Conditions of plantation of this our providid Land dated the fifth day of
April one thousand six hundred Eighty four and remaining upon Record
in our said Province of Maryland IN DEED therefore hereby Grant
unto him the said Adam Shapley all that tract or piece of Land called Adam

heires from time to time to collect and receive the same shall accept in
discharge thereof at the place of his and our heires or such officer or officers
as aforesaid. PROVIDED that if the said sum for a fine for alienation
shall not be paid unto us and our heires or such officer or officers as aforesaid
before such alienation and the said alienation entered upon Record either in
the Provincial Court or in the County Court where the said piece of Land
lyeth within one month next after such alienation the said alienation shall
bed void and of none Effect. Given all our said fifty of st^t Maryes under the
